SGAEC

The Student Government Association Executive Council serves as the official voice of students at the University of Tennessee, Memphis. Its membership is charged with insuring that the concerns of all students are acknowledged within the university community.

The 1993-94 SGAEC began its term by addressing an issue that affects everyone: campus safety. The Campus Safety Committee, in meetings with UT Police and the administration, brought forward a number of security concerns leading to marked improvements in campus safety, most notable of which was a new card reader system. In order to improve communication between students and the administration, we continued to meet regularly with our Chancellor, and formed new ties with Vice-Chancellors and their respective departments, resulting in a mutual understanding of each others concerns. The SGAEC, in union with Faculty, Student Affairs Deans, and the Office of Student Affairs, accomplished the phenomenal task of reviewing and revising our Student Honor Code this year. We also sponsored a number of events for students and the campus, such as an excellent Substance Awareness Series, along with entertainment events, such as the Luau, Neo Gio, and Springfest. Our Multicultural Awareness Committee continued with our efforts to promote cultural sensitivity among the campus community by working for multicultural curricula in each of the colleges and through sponsorship of a series on cultural diversity. From this we all learned that "through diversity we grow stronger as a University." Finally, we initiated this campus' first concerted effort to address mounting increases in student tuition. Through the efforts of a new Government Affairs Committee, we began a state-wide lobbying effort which involved a letter writing campaign and meetings with the UT lobbyist, the Tennessee Higher Education Commission, and legislators in our state capitol.

The success of our programs this year required the teamwork of students, faculty, staff, and administrators. We thank everyone for their support of the SGAEC this year, especially our advisors Dr. Pamela Moon and Vice-Chancellor for Student Affairs, Bill Robinson, who together have served as the foundation of the SGAEC. As the University of Tennessee celebrates its bicentennial this year, we can only hope that our efforts will live on into the next two hundred years.

1794

The University of Tennessee traces its origin to the founding of Blount College in Knoxville in 1794. In 1806 this small private college became a public institution and was renamed East Tennessee College. In 1840 it was renamed East Tennessee University. Later, in 1869 East Tennessee University was designated as a federal land grant college for the State of Tennessee. In 1879, the college was recognized by the state legislature as the official state university and was renamed The University of Tennessee.

In addition to its home campus at Knoxville, The University of Tennessee has many facilities throughout the state to meet regional and community education needs. The present locations for The University of Tennessee degree-granting campuses, in addition to the home campus at Knoxville, include UT Memphis, UT Martin, UT Chattanooga and the Space Institute located in Tullahoma, Tennessee.

The University of Tennessee College of Medicine traces its origin back to 1851 as the Medical Department of the University of Nashville. In 1909, the Medical Department of The University of Tennessee and the Medical Department of the University of Nashville were considered as The University of Tennessee Department of Medicine and was located in Nashville. In 1911, The University of Tennessee Department of Medicine was moved from Nashville to Memphis and was merged

with the College of Physicians and Surgeons (founded in 1906) and with the Memphis Hospital Medical College (founded in 1876) and became The University of Tennessee College of Medicine. That same year, together with the Colleges of Dentistry and Pharmacy, the College of Medicine formed The University of Tennessee Medical Units campus as Memphis. In 1926, the College of Nursing was added to the campus, and in 1928, the School of Biological Sciences was organized and added to the Medical Units. In 1972, the College of Community and Allied Health Professions was established. The college is now named the College of Allied Health Sciences. In 1974 the name of the Memphis campus was changed from The University of Tennessee Medical Units to The University of Tennessee Center for the Health Sciences. In July of 1979, the College of Basic Medical Sciences (formerly the school of Biological Sciences) was consolidated into the College of Medicine. In addition to the five colleges, there is a College of Health Sciences which awards the M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in all of the basic science disciplines related to medicine. There is also a College of Social Work located within the campus complex that is an extension of university programs governed by the UT Knoxville campus.

In 1986, the official name of the campus was changed to The University of Tennessee, Memphis.

George Washington was in his second term as President of the United States in 1794, and in Europe, the French Revolution was nearing a climax. In Knoxville, capital of the territory south of the River Ohio, the Rev. Samuel Carrick formed Blount College in order to "teach a competent Introduction to the Latin and Greek languages." It was from these humble beginnings that the University of Tennessee developed.

The University is now celebrating its Bicentennial in a big way. UT Vice President Sammie Lynn Puett, who chairs the Bicentennial planning committee, says the University's 200th birthday is a statewide celebration.

"For more than a year, UT staff from across the state have been looking for ways to involve all Tennesseans in our year-long celebration. UT belongs to all of us, and we want to share the joy and pride of looking backward as well as forward to the University's next century of service."

said Puett.

The Memphis campus has joined in the festivities. Students and faculty were given a sneak preview of the Bicentennial logo on December 22, 1993 at the Chancellor's Christmas party. Chancellor Rice unveiled the logo as a giant cake, laden with sparklers, was carried in.

The official start of the 200th birthday celebration took place on January 13, 1994. A satellite television hook-up brought the Memphis campus together with UT units in Chattanooga, Martin, and Tullahoma to witness the festivities in Knoxville at the Thompson-Boling arena. Speaking to the UT faculty, students, staff, and friends were UT President Joe Johnson and Chancellor Bill Snyder. State, local, and national governmental officials brought Bicentennial greetings live and by videotape. Even ABC's "Good Morning America" got in on the action by broadcasting a kick-off salute.



THE IMHOTEP



In 1980, the IMHOTEP Society became an official and recognized organization on campus, for the purpose of honoring students, faculty, staff, and alumni who have significantly contributed to student life and student process at UT Memphis. It was recognized that many student leaders, in performing their functions and assignments, may have sacrificed high academic accomplishments and thus did not receive recognition through those organizations which traditionally honor students for high academic achievement.

While the principle objective of the Society is to reward and recognize student leadership and service on campus, a secondary goal is to inspire students to continue leadership and service roles as alumni of the University.

The central administration of the University of Tennessee — headed by the President of the University, who is directly accountable to the Board of Trustees — has general responsibility for the overall operation of the University.

The Board of Trustees, the University's governing body, consists of five ex-officio members (the Governor of Tennessee, the President of the University, The Commissioner of Education, the Commissioner of Agriculture, the Executive Director of the Tennessee Higher Education Commission) and eighteen additional appointed members, including one student.

Its purpose is to establish policies controlling the scope of the educational opportunities to be offered by the University as well as policies determining its operation in general. The Board has full authority to determine and to control the activities and policies of all organizations that bear the name of the University. It also controls the election, appointment and removal of all the officers, faculty, and employees of the University.

It is a service that wells up from the entire complex of his personality. True, some specialized and highly developed techniques may be included, but their mode of expression is given its deepest meaning by the personality of the practitioner. In a very real sense his professional service cannot be separate from his personal being. He has no goods to sell, no land to till; his only asset is himself. It turns out that there is no right price for service, for what is a share of a man worth? If he does not contain the quality of integrity, he is worthless. If he does, he is priceless. The value is either nothing or it is infinite. So, do not try to set a price on yourselves. Do not measure out your professional services on an apothecary's scale and say, "Only this for so much." Do not debase yourselves by equating your souls to what they will bring in the market. Do not be a miser, hoarding your talents and abilities and knowledge, either among yourselves or in your dealings with your clients, patients, or flock. Rather be reckless and spendthrift, pouring out your talent to all to whom it can be of service. Throw it away, waste it; and in the spending it can be of service. Do not keep a watchful eye lest you slip and give away a little bit of what you might have sold. Do not censor your thoughts to gain a wider audience. Like love, talent is useful only in its expenditure, and it is never exhausted. Certain it is that man must eat, so set what price you must on your service. But never confuse the performance, which is great, with the compensation, be it money, power, or fame, which is trivial.

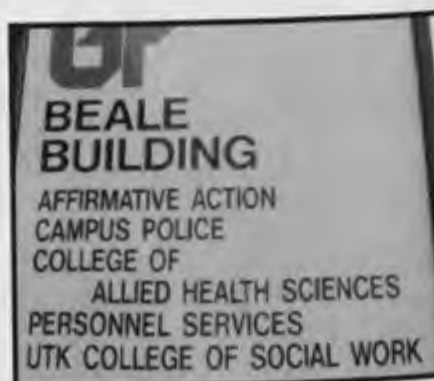
