Asklepieion is a word derived from the name of Aesculapius, the Greek god of medicine and healing. Aesculapius was honored and worshipped throughout the Greek world by persons seeking the healing powers of the physician. Temples were erected in honor Aesculapius near healing springs or high mountains. Those who worshipped him were known as Aesculapae. Therefore, the temples in his honor were known as Aesculapions (Asklepieions). In the ancient city of Memphis, on the Nile River, there was a temple where people went for worship and for care. In our own city of Memphis, on the Mississippi River, people come to our Asklepieion for healing and care.

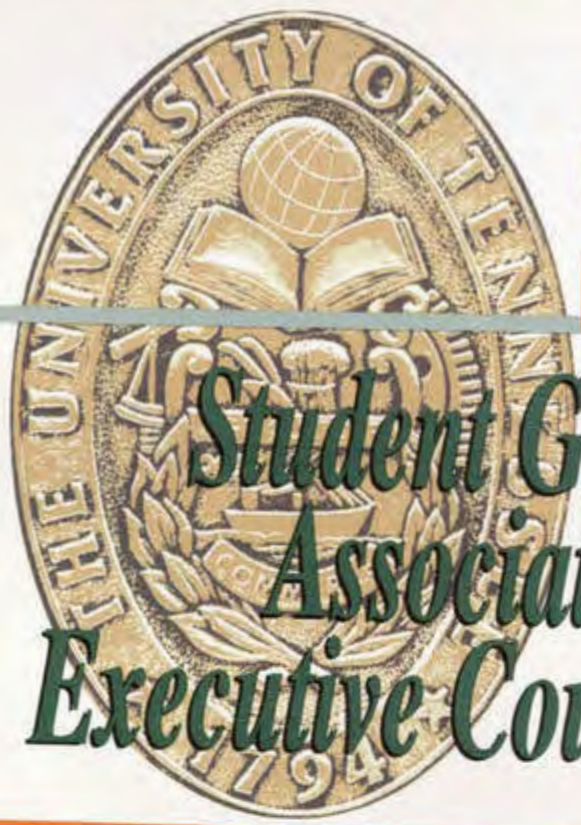

This issue of the *Asklepieion* yearbook is dedicated to William C. Robinson. Mr. Robinson dedicated his professional career to working with students at UT Memphis through various student affairs positions beginning in 1962 as Assistant Director of Student Welfare. Since then, he has been an intricate part in the planning and development of many student facilities and services as they are today. Robinson originated, planned and developed the building of the Student Alumni Center and the Fitness Center in 1963-69, and the UT Doctors sports field in 1980. He has directed the publication of the student yearbook, the *Asklepieion*, since 1964 and has directed the graduation programs since 1969. In 1970 he planned the reorganization and the administration of the Student Government Association Executive Council (SGAEC), and originated the Imhotep Society to recognize student, faculty and staff leadership and service. In May, 1994, Mr. Robinson was named the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs and served in that role until 1997. On behalf of all students, past and present, the yearbook staff is pleased to dedicate the 1998 *Asklepieion*, to Bill Robinson.

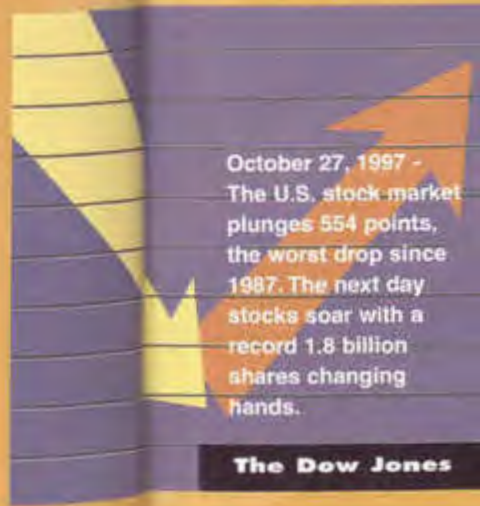

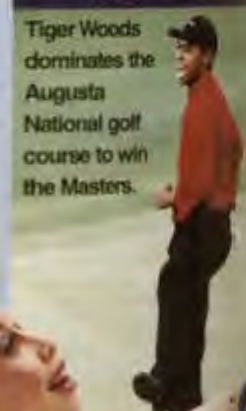
